EDUCATION STABILIZATION FUND

The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act, or CARES Act, includes \$30.75 billion for an Education Stabilization Fund, to remain available through September 30, 2021, to prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus. After set asides for the outlying areas, Bureau of Indian Education, and 1% for the Secretary to make competitive grants to states with the highest coronavirus burden, of the remaining funds, 9.8% is reserved for the Governor's Emergency Education Relief Fund (\$2.95 billion), 43.9% is reserved for the Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund (\$13.2 billion), and 46.3% is reserved for the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (\$13.95 billion). Awards to Governors may be used to provide emergency support through grants to local educational agencies (LEAs) and institutions of higher education (IHEs) that have been most significantly impacted by coronavirus. Under the emergency fund for elementary and secondary schools, not less than 90% must be used for subgrants to LEAs in proportion to the funds LEAs received under Title I, Part A. Remaining funds will be used for emergency needs as determined by the State educational agency. Similarly, of the funds for higher education, 90% must be distributed to IHEs. Of the remaining funds, 7.5% is reserved for Historically Black Colleges and Universities and other minority-serving institutions, and 2.5% for IHEs having the greatest unmet needs related to coronavirus. IHEs are required to use no less than 50% of their funds to provide emergency financial aid grants to students for expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to coronavirus.
